children's Health Ministries was born as a response to Jesus' commands to show His love in a hurting world by feeding the hungry and caring for the sick. What began as a small malnutrition program has now grown into a medical center where some of the hungriest and sickest children in Haiti receive lifesaving care.

Malnutrition is one of the largest causes of death among children in developing countries. In Carrefour, Haiti 1 in 3 children under 2 years old are malnourished and 1 in 7 won't make it to their fifth birthday due to the effects of chronic undernutrition and disease. It doesn't have to be this way! Nearly all deaths due to starvation or related comorbidities (due to weakened immune systems) are preventable with early nutrition intervention and basic medical care.

Children's Health Ministries has been treating and preventing malnutrition in Carrefour since 2012 with high levels of success. The top four most important supplements in our battle against malnutrition are Plumpy Nut, F-75 therapeutic milk, infant formula, and nutritious meal packs. All of these products provide high quality, dense nutrition for vulnerable children aged 0-5 years.
