Tori Jeseritz from Youth With A Mission (YWAM)

I have the honor of getting to serve with YWAM in Kona, Hawaii. I am helping lead the Endeavor DTS, a pioneering school that was started in 2023. A DTS is a 6-month program created to help young adults go deeper in their faith and be trained for cross-cultural missions. In the last two years we have had 200 students attend and have sent out 22 short-term outreach teams all over the globe. My heart is specifically for the nation of Nepal, which I have been able to lead three 3-month outreaches to, and hope to move long-term there in the future.
