Our pastors have prayed for us in moments of joy and in seasons of struggle, faithfully lifting us before the Lord and we have the privilege of doing the same for them. Let's ask God to protect, strengthen, and refresh them as they continue to quide us closer to Jesus.

WAYS YOU CAN BE PRAYING FOR OUR PASTORS

Rest and Refreshment –Pray that they would find time and space to rest—not just physically, but also mentally, emotionally, and spiritually. Ask that God would renew their energy, refresh their souls, and give them peace in the midst of full schedules and busy seasons.

Health and Healing – Pray for their bodies and minds, that God would give them strength and resilience. Ask Him to bring healing quickly when they face illness or fatigue so that they have the strength to live out all that He's called them to.

Encouragement and Support – Our pastors are not meant to carry the weight of ministry alone. Pray that God would surround them with the right people, in the right places, at the right times—those who will encourage them, walk alongside them, and help shoulder the load so they can lead out of a full cup.

Wisdom and Discernment – Pray that God would continue to fill our pastors with wisdom and give them discernment as they guide our church family. Ask that they would hear His voice clearly and have the courage to follow His leading in every step.

Relationships – Pray for their families and friendships, that they would be able to be fully present with those they love and that God would give them balance between ministry and home. Ask that their relationships would be sources of joy, strength, and encouragement.

Relationship with God – Most of all, pray for their personal walk with Jesus. Ask that they would know His presence deeply, continue to grow in their understanding of who He is and what He's called them to, and be refreshed in their own spiritual health so that everything they do flows out of intimacy with Him.
