Sadly, too many Christians have lost sight of what the good news actually is and how to put it into action. In this 8-session RightNow Media online Bible study, Bible teacher Jada Edwards brings the clarity that we need for what the gospel is and how we live it out. Romans is a deep dive into doctrine, not for knowledge's sake, but for life change.
