Last week we had the opportunity to bring 21 students and leaders to Des Moines to partner with Shalom Covenant Church, a vibrant community of Congolese immigrants, in putting on their very first Vacation Bible School! It was a great week of serving together, worshiping in new and powerful ways, and hearing stories of God's faithfulness.

One of the biggest blessings of the week was watching our students step up and lead with confidence, joy, and compassion. They took ownership of every part of VBS—from leading opening and closing assemblies to running games, snacks, crafts, and teaching the Bible lesson. Even more meaningful was the way they poured into the kids relationally, taking time to listen, play, encourage, and connect.

Along with VBS, our team jumped in to help with projects around the church including cleaning, gardening, and building new picnic tables. We also had the chance to serve at a local nursing home, pack meals with Meals from the Heartland, and visit the Shalom Community Impact Center, which provides incredible support for refugee families in the area.

Our team built lasting relationships with the kids and families we met—connections we'll carry with us for a long time. The church was deeply grateful for the partnership, and while many of our experiences stretched us and often pushed us out of our comfort zones, we left inspired by their faith despite hardships and blessed by their hospitality. We're excited to see how God continues to grow this connection and look forward to future opportunities to serve together!

Alaska Christian College Missions Trip Recap

Our team of 21 adults served at Alaska Christian College June 14-21. We flew into Anchorage and drove to Soldotna, Alaska where the campus is located. On Sunday, a crew of 12 went halibut fishing and caught their limit. Nine other group members attended church and then went on a hike along the Russian River. Our work week had us working on various projects: cement work, building a shed for a backup generator, demo and painting one side of a duplex, lighting/electrical projects in multiple locations, sewing projects, gravel work for parking lots, grounds keeping, mowing, excavating for a retaining wall, vehicle repair and maintenance, painting, weeding, and chain sawing. Another group from Nashville installed siding on the gym. A highlight of the week was a tour of the campus and hearing God stories from Keith Hamilton, President of ACC. Many were in tears each noon lunch as student ambassadors shared their testimonies of redemption and restoration in their lives. It was a privilege to serve at Alaska Christian College and be part of what God is doing there.


